HARMONIZING FUTURES: EMPOWERING LIFELONG LEARNERS FROM FOSTER CARE TO HIGHER EDUCATION

ABSTRACT:

This panel session will showcase Embark Georgia, a comprehensive statewide initiative focused on enhancing the higher educational experiences of students who have experienced foster care and/or homelessness. Since its inception in 2012, Embark Georgia has mobilized public two- and four-year higher education institutions alongside child welfare and K-12 professionals to increase institutional capacity and create a robust support network. Led by a panel composed of Embark program planners, faculty researchers, and student mentors, this session will provide attendees with insights into our successful strategies for statewide engagement. The panelists will share their diverse perspectives on one of Embark's main initiatives, our pre-college summer programs for youth with experiences in foster care.
