# SERVICE-LEARNING WITH DIGITAL PRESENTATION : A CONTENT ANALYSIS

### ABSTRACT:

This study investigates the service-learning activities of 26 graduate students who completed a digital preservation course in Fall 2024 through a content analysis of journaling assignments and a survey of community partners' feedback. In an influx of technologies, delivering the digital preservation course online has been challenging. A service-learning approach is seen promising to help students achieve better learning outcomes.
